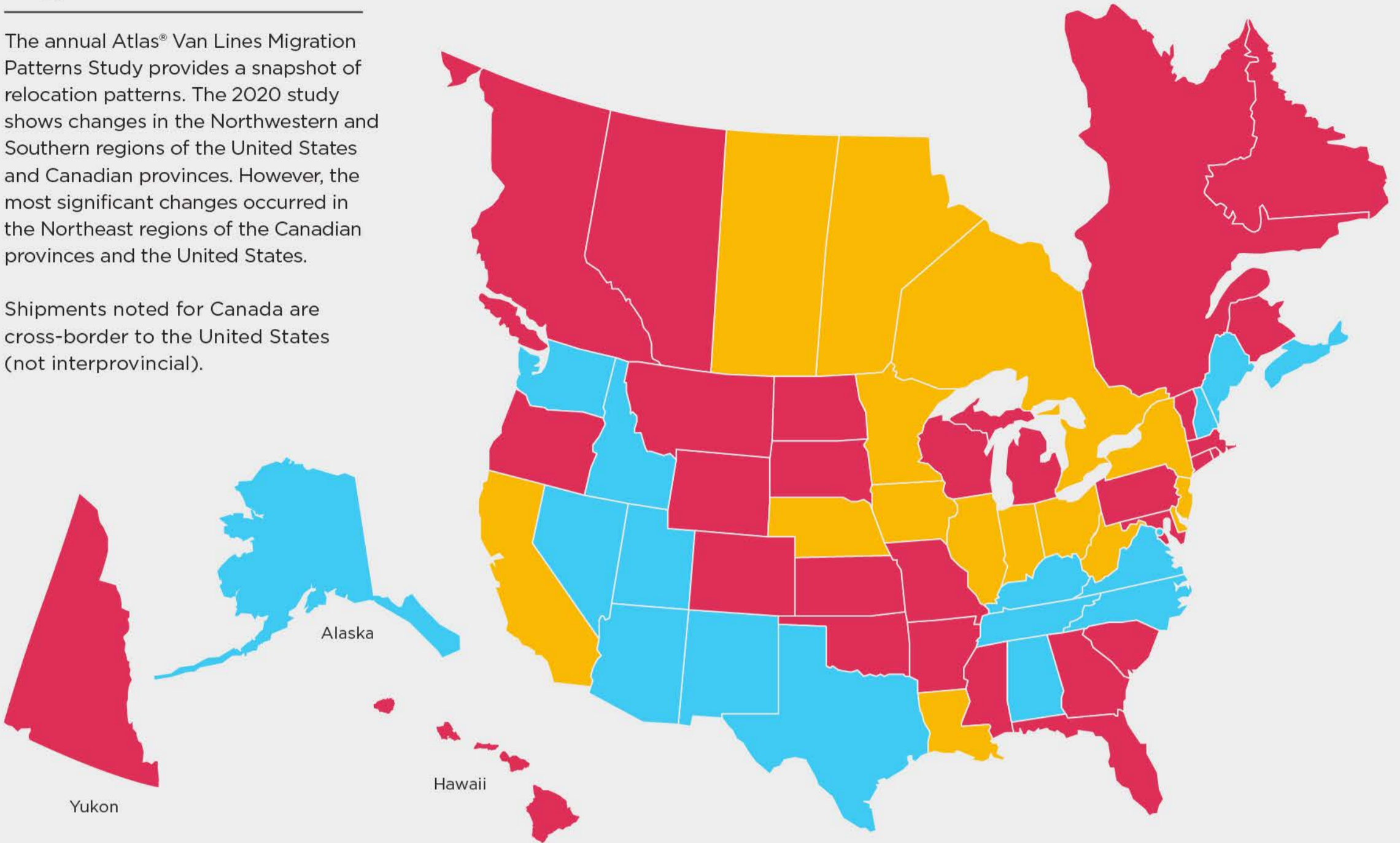


Migration Pattern

The annual Atlas® Van Lines Migration Patterns Study provides a snapshot of relocation patterns. The 2020 study shows changes in the Northwestern and Southern regions of the United States and Canadian provinces. However, the most significant changes occurred in the Northeast regions of the Canadian provinces and the United States.

Shipments noted for Canada are cross-border to the United States (not interprovincial).



Highest % Inbound

Percent of total interstate/interprovince moves that were inbound.

62%	Maine	50% New Brunswick

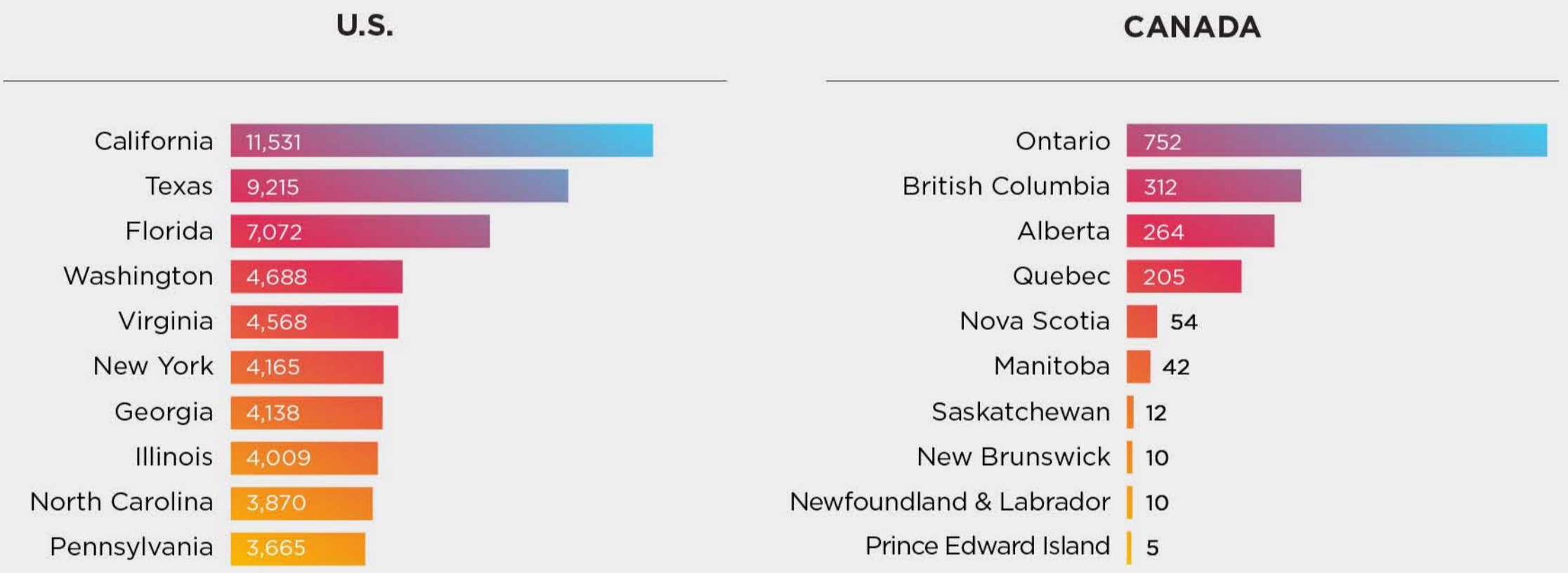
Highest % Outbound

Percent of total interstate/interprovince moves that were outbound.

63%	Illinois	91% Saskatchewan
61%	New Jersey	64% Manitoba
