Who attends?

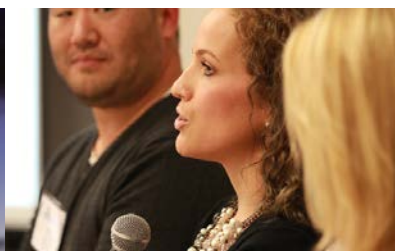
Forum attendance is around 300 people. These include Atlas executives, agency representatives, and invited guests—professionals working in corporate relocation.

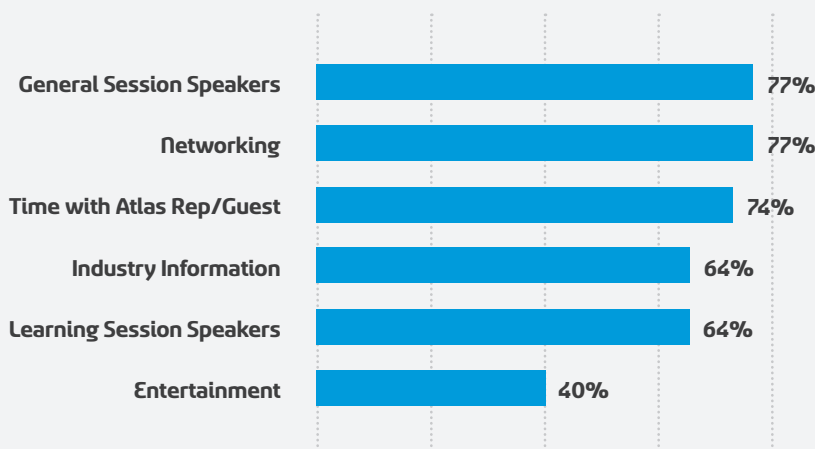
